Dear Affiliate Leaders,

ASRT understands the many challenges the COVID-19 pandemic has created for your annual meetings. Many affiliates canceled their face-to-face meetings and were unable to have an official ASRT representative.

As you know, affiliates are currently on a three-year rotation for an official representative from ASRT. Because every affiliate that was due to be provided an official representative in 2020 was unable to take advantage of this benefit, the ASRT Board of Directors has decided to push out the current three-year rotation by one year. As a result, ASRT is planning for affiliates who would have received an official ASRT representative for their 2020 conference to now receive an official representative in 2021. Likewise, affiliates who were due for an official visit in 2021 should receive their official visit in 2022 and those who were due a visit in 2022 will receive a visit in 2023.

While we understand this may cause some inconvenience in your planning processes, this was determined to be the best possible solution in order to maintain a fair and equal opportunity for all affiliates. Also, please keep in mind that COVID-19 will likely continue to create challenges, so ASRT might need to re-evaluate its plan for official visits in the spring of 2021. We will continue updating affiliates accordingly.

We hope to return to business as usual soon and meet with you face to face. Until then, thank you for your continued patience and understanding.
