



WVSRT NEWS RELEASE: HB4434 Health Care Sustainability Study

Dear West Virginia Medical Imaging Professionals,

House Bill 4434 was signed into law during the 2020 WV Legislative Session. Attached are three (3) documents detailing the changes impacting the West Virginia Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy Technology Board of Examiners, and ultimately could impact Licensure of Medical Imaging Professionals in West Virginia.

The West Virginia Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy Technology Board of Examiners will be required to provide contact information for every licensee to WorkForce West Virginia. Medical Imaging Professionals in West Virginia can expect to receive a survey in the very near future from WorkForce West Virginia. This survey should come in one of the following methods:
