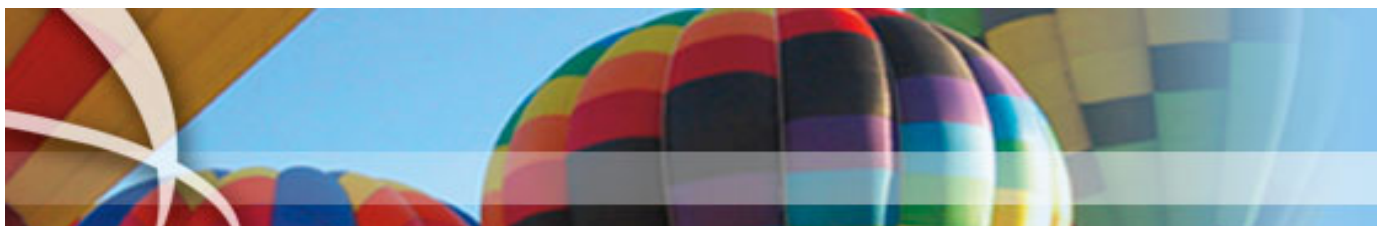

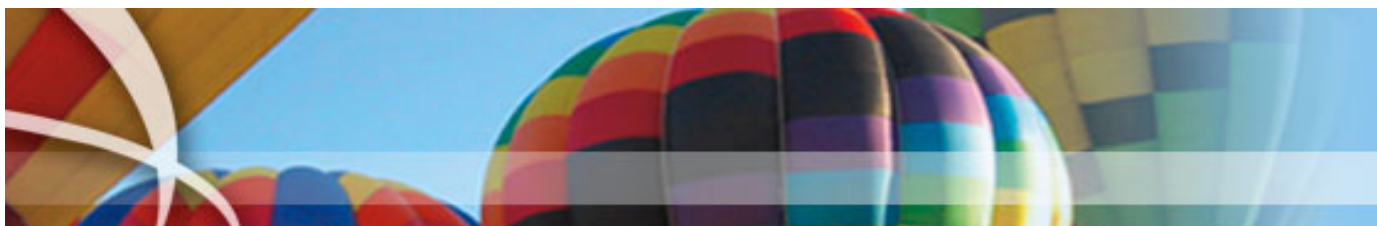

  - Active, Associate, LXMO, R A members: From \$105.00 to \$125.00

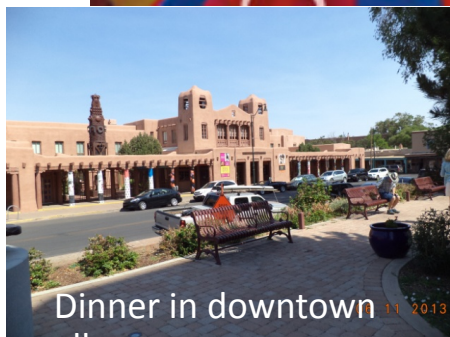
